For the second time in four years, Alaskans have once again voted for open primaries and ranked choice voting, for preserving their voter freedom and power, and for protecting their right to vote for the best candidate, regardless of political party.

No on 2 Executive Director Juli Lucky and Campaign Chair Lesil McGuire released the following joint statement:
